Many practitioners lack specialized training, compromising depth in cultural interpretation. Third, outdated dissemination methods persist, with 78% of couplets still distributed through print media according to 2022 surveys. Digital transformation remains limited, and creative integration with other cultural forms like architecture or performance art is underdeveloped.

Addressing these issues requires coordinated strategies: establishing quality control standards for couplet creation, implementing digital archiving and AR-enhanced display systems, and developing cross-disciplinary cultural products. Strengthening professional training for cultural stewards and creating youth-oriented interactive platforms could bridge traditional artistry with modern expressive needs.
